- Create original blog posts and content pieces that provide valuable insights, tips, and resources for young adults entering the workforce.
- Implement & Manage the editorial calendar and schedule content publication across



- various platforms.
- Monitor blog performance metrics and adjust content strategy as needed to optimise engagement and reach.
- Work closely with the CEO and other key stakeholders to ensure alignment with organisational goals and messaging.
